A NEW VETERAN AND FAMILY HOUSING DEVELOPMENT

Mercy Housing will begin construction on 60 units of high-quality affordable rental housing for veterans who have experienced homelessness as well as veteran families. The site is a 1.5-acre property at the corner of San Antonio Drive and Foster Road. Upon completion, the community will create affordable apartments and provide amenities such as private outside space, laundry rooms, a community room, and property management and resident services offices. Veterans Villas at San Antonio Drive is the seventh community developed by Mercy Housing California specifically for veterans.

Mercy Housing California is the state's most experienced owner of service-enriched housing for families with low incomes.
